As of the most recent available data (**January 04, 2021**), **22.0% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **23.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **20.1% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **24.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 04, 2021**), **30.1% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **38.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.6% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **same** credits.
