As of the most recent available data (**January 05, 2021**), **21.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **22.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **19.6% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **23.5% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 05, 2021**), **29.5% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **38.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.0% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **36.5% more** credits.
