As of the most recent available data (January 06, 2021), 19.9% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 20.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 17.9% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 21.8% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 06, 2021), 29.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 37.6% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 28.3% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 36.8% more credits.
