As of the most recent available data (**January 07, 2021**), **19.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **17.6% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **21.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**January 07, 2021**), **29.3% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **37.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.6% more** graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **37.1% more** credits.
