As of the most recent available data (January 07, 2021), 19.4% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2020 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 20.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 17.6% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 21.4% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 07, 2021), 29.3% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 37.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 28.6% more graduate students enrolled for the 2020 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 37.1% more credits.
