As of the most recent available data (**November 05, 2021**), **24.0% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **22.5% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **64.2% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **60.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 05, 2021**), **36.0% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **37.7% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **85.5% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **84.1% fewer** credits.
