As of the most recent available data (November 09, 2021), 14.7% fewer undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 12.0% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 55.8% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 51.2% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 09, 2021), 42.7% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 37.7% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 80.7% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 77.6% fewer credits.
