As of the most recent available data (**November 19, 2021**), **1.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **19.0% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 19, 2021), 28.9% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 20.4% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 55.1% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 49.4% fewer credits.
