As of the most recent available data (**November 22, 2021**), **2.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **6.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **17.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **11.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 22, 2021**), **27.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **53.3% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **47.1% fewer** credits.
