As of the most recent available data (**November 23, 2021**), **3.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **15.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **9.8% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 23, 2021**), **29.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **19.6% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **52.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **45.8% fewer** credits.
