As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2021**), **3.5% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **9.2% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **2.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2021**), 29.3% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 19.6% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 49.6% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 43.0% fewer credits.
