As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2021**), **4.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **1.1% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2021**), **27.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **18.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **44.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **38.6% fewer** credits.
