As of the most recent available data (**December 07, 2021**), **4.8% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **9.3% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **3.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **2.1% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 07, 2021**), **18.7% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **11.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **37.5% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **32.1% fewer** credits.
