As of the most recent available data (**December 10, 2021**), 6.2% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 0.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 5.9% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 10, 2021**), **14.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **7.4% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **32.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **27.9% fewer** credits.
