As of the most recent available data (**December 16, 2021**), **7.6% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **12.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **2.3% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **8.7% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 16, 2021**), **7.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **2.0% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.5% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **24.2% fewer** credits.
