As of the most recent available data (**December 22, 2021**), 6.3% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.9% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 12.4% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 22, 2021**), **8.3% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **3.8% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **25.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **21.1% fewer** credits.
