As of the most recent available data (**December 27, 2021**), 4.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 9.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 6.6% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 13.5% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 27, 2021**), **1.7% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **1.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **18.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.5% fewer** credits.
