As of the most recent available data (**December 29, 2021**), **6.3% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **11.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **7.9% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **15.3% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 29, 2021**), **4.6% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **1.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.5% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes **10.7% fewer** credits.
