As of the most recent available data (January 04, 2022), 4.5% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 5.2% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 12.9% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 04, 2022), same graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 0.4% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 10.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 9.5% fewer credits.
