As of the most recent available data (January 05, 2022), 4.9% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.6% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.2% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 11.9% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 05, 2022), 0.2% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 0.4% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 10.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 9.3% fewer credits.
