As of the most recent available data (January 06, 2022), 5.1% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 4.1% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 11.6% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 06, 2022), 0.2% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 0.9% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 9.8% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 9.5% fewer credits.
