As of the most recent available data (January 10, 2022), 5.2% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2021 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.6% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 3.9% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2022 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 11.5% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 10, 2022), 8.3% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 8.6% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 9.4% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2021 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2020 January Intersession, and this constitutes 9.1% fewer credits.
