As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2022**), **12.0% fewer** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.9% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **24.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **23.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2022**), **21.8% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2022 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **31.2% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **56.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2023 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2022 January Intersession, and this constitutes **56.5% fewer** credits.
