As of the most recent available data (**November 06, 2023**), **26.9% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **20.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **65.3% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **63.4% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 06, 2023**), **54.4% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **56.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **72.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **71.1% fewer** credits.
