As of the most recent available data (November 07, 2023), 14.9% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 11.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 58.2% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 56.0% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 07, 2023), 73.8% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 79.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 63.4% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 62.5% fewer credits.
