As of the most recent available data (**November 07, 2023**), **14.9% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **11.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **58.2% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **56.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 07, 2023**), **73.8% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **79.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **63.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **62.5% fewer** credits.
