As of the most recent available data (November 08, 2023), 27.1% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 23.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 53.8% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 51.1% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 08, 2023), 96.3% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 101.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 58.7% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 57.9% fewer credits.
