As of the most recent available data (November 09, 2023), 35.0% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 30.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 50.9% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 48.5% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 09, 2023), 107.5% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 112.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 56.3% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 55.6% fewer credits.
