As of the most recent available data (November 10, 2023), 37.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 32.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 45.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 42.8% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 10, 2023), 103.3% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 109.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 51.3% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 50.7% fewer credits.
