As of the most recent available data (**November 13, 2023**), **34.5% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **31.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **37.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **35.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 13, 2023**), **77.1% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **79.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **49.2% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **48.2% fewer** credits.
