As of the most recent available data (**November 15, 2023**), **39.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **35.0% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **28.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **25.7% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 15, 2023**), **91.2% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **94.3% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **43.2% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **41.5% fewer** credits.
