As of the most recent available data (November 16, 2023), 46.2% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 40.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 25.0% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 22.7% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 16, 2023), 93.8% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 96.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 42.4% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 40.8% fewer credits.
