As of the most recent available data (**November 17, 2023**), **34.4% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **32.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **21.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **18.9% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 17, 2023**), 60.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 63.5% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 41.1% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 39.1% fewer credits.
