As of the most recent available data (**November 20, 2023**), **13.0% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **13.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **19.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.5% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 20, 2023**), **47.1% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **51.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **40.0% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **38.0% fewer** credits.
