As of the most recent available data (November 20, 2023), 13.0% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 13.1% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 19.4% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 16.5% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 20, 2023**), 47.1% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 51.7% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 40.0% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 38.0% fewer credits.
