As of the most recent available data (**November 24, 2023**), **9.3% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **9.9% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **15.9% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **13.0% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 24, 2023**), **37.3% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **37.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **38.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **37.5% fewer** credits.
