As of the most recent available data (**November 27, 2023**), **9.9% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **10.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.5% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **11.4% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 27, 2023**), **37.6% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **37.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **38.4% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **37.0% fewer** credits.
