As of the most recent available data (**November 28, 2023**), **7.3% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **8.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **13.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **10.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**November 28, 2023**), **36.6% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **35.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **37.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **35.7% fewer** credits.
