As of the most recent available data (November 30, 2023), 9.9% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 10.3% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 11.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 8.3% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (November 30, 2023), 40.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 38.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 35.5% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 34.4% fewer credits.
