As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2023**), **9.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **9.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **10.4% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **7.3% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2023**), **33.0% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **32.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **35.3% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **33.9% fewer** credits.
