As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2023**), 9.1% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 9.8% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 10.4% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 7.3% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 01, 2023**), 33.0% more graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 32.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 35.3% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 33.9% fewer credits.
