As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2023**), **3.7% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **4.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **8.1% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **5.4% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 06, 2023**), **27.4% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **27.3% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **33.9% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **32.6% fewer** credits.
