As of the most recent available data (**December 07, 2023**), 5.8% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 6.3% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 6.3% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 3.7% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 07, 2023**), **31.0% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **30.2% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **32.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **31.1% fewer** credits.
