As of the most recent available data (**December 08, 2023**), **7.1% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **7.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **4.8% fewer** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **2.1% fewer** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 08, 2023**), **9.0% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **7.8% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **26.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **26.4% fewer** credits.
