As of the most recent available data (**December 12, 2023**), 3.8% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 3.9% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 3.6% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 1.1% fewer credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 12, 2023**), **0.7% more** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **2.5% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **23.2% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **22.4% fewer** credits.
