As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2023**), 5.7% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 6.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 2.0% fewer undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 1.0% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 18, 2023**), **2.0% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **0.4% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **21.1% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **20.3% fewer** credits.
