As of the most recent available data (**December 25, 2023**), **4.2% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **5.6% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **0.7% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.4% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 25, 2023**), **4.2% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **2.3% fewer** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **16.6% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **16.8% fewer** credits.
