As of the most recent available data (**December 26, 2023**), **5.0% more** undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **6.1% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **1.4% more** undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **4.9% more** credits.

As of the most recent available data (**December 26, 2023**), **2.1% fewer** graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking **0.7% more** credits than they were at this time last year. There are **14.7% fewer** graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes **14.2% fewer** credits.
