As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2024), 3.6% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 4.0% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 3.3% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.0% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 02, 2024), 1.4% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 0.1% fewer credits than they were at this time last year. There are 6.3% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.5% fewer credits.
