As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2024), 3.0% more undergraduates have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 3.4% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 2.7% more undergraduates enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 5.3% more credits.

As of the most recent available data (January 03, 2024), 1.1% fewer graduate students have enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than were enrolled in the 2023 January Intersession at this time last year. They are taking 0.2% more credits than they were at this time last year. There are 6.1% fewer graduate students enrolled for the 2024 January Intersession than the final enrollment count for the 2023 January Intersession, and this constitutes 6.2% fewer credits.
